The Haring Center for Research and Training in Inclusive Education is an integrated early childhood program dedicated to improving the lives of children with and without special needs and their families through inclusive education. Inclusion is an active commitment by a community to ensure that every child is engaged and can participate fully with his or her peers.

The Experimental Education Unit (EEU), is one of the Haring Center's three units. All EEU programs are free and promote the development of children's cognitive, motor, communication and social interaction skills through specific educational and therapeutic interventions. At the EEU, scholars, educators, service professionals and graduate students work with the school's 250 children who range in age from birth through kindergarten. The programs always include side-by-side learning of typically developing children and children with various developmental disabilities.
